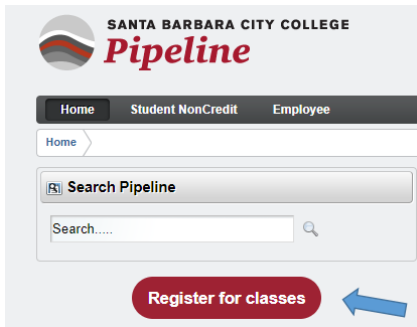
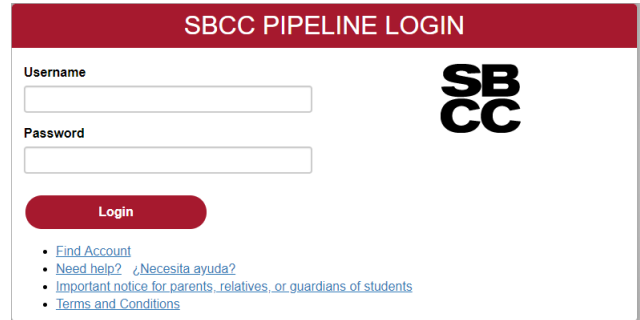
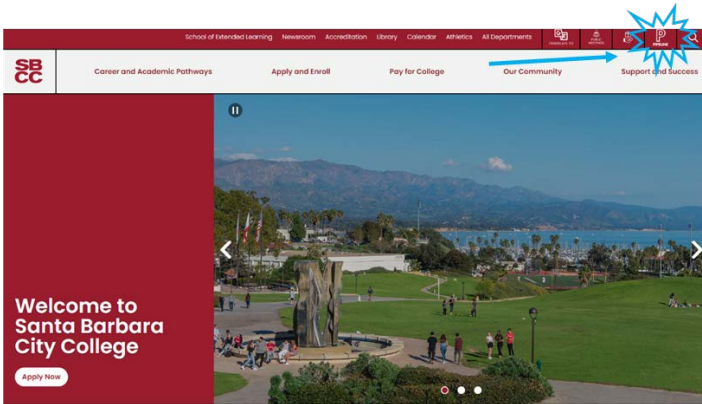
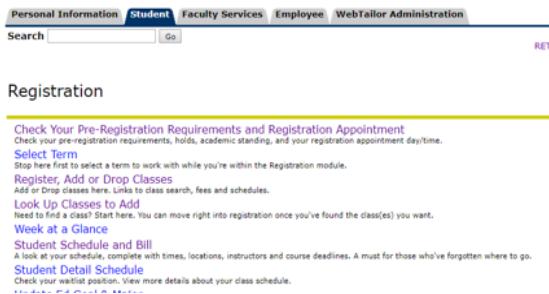


How to view your SBCC SEL noncredit class (state funded/free) registrations

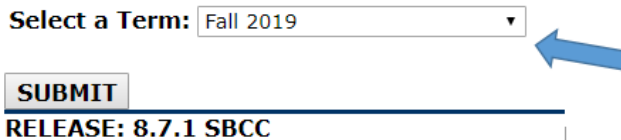


Click on the red 'Register for classes' button

#### Account Information

Fees are due within seven (7) days of registration or you may be dropped for non-payment of fees. Students will not be dropped for non-payment after instruction has begun. It is the student's responsibility to manage their registration and to drop class(es) by the stated deadlines. Students who remain enrolled after the refund deadline show above are not eligible for a refund and will be held financially responsible for the related fees, even if they drop the class or are dropped by their instructor.

Fees may be paid by credit or debit card immediately following online registration or by cash, check or money order at the Cashier's Office in the Student Services Building, SS-150. Unpaid fees may result in a financial hold. Financial holds will prevent you from enrollment activities such as, but not limited to, registering for courses, viewing grades, ordering transcripts and receiving a diploma.
